



Pedestrian Detour Along Westbound ChampionsGate Boulevard (C.R. 532) at the I-4 & ChampionsGate Interchange

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is detouring pedestrian traffic on the westbound sidewalk (south side of the road) of ChampionsGate Boulevard (County Road 532) at the interchange of Interstate 4 (I-4) and ChampionsGate. The detour will begin Wednesday, May 7, and is anticipated to remain in place until late 2025, allowing for crews to reconstruct the eastbound and westbound I-4 bridges. Signage will guide pedestrians from either side of I-4 to cross to the center median area and follow the protected path safely to the other side. While the bike lane is unavailable, cyclists are advised to dismount and follow the pedestrian detour until the bike lane resumes. Please follow all posted signs and use pedestrian signals.
